Pre-School Room

The children in preschool have been learning about Winter. They have used their science skills to learn about the different ways ice melts. They have talked about how ice forms and the cold. They have had fun making welly prints as well as playing with the ice in the water tray. We have developed our fine motor skills threading beads onto pipe cleaners. We used this activity to develop our mathematical skills also by sorting the colours and making patterns. We have read our Book of the Month "The Gruffalo's Child". We created a tuff tray and explored the characters and retold the story. We talked about the rhyming words throughout the story which the children enjoyed, this activity helps develop your child's pre reading skills

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Things to do at home this month

Pre-School

The children will be reading the story "When will it snow?" You can read the story at home and talk about the characters. The story is a good way to talk about the seasons and why it snows. You can talk about dressing for the snowy weather and what type of clothes we need to keep warm.

We will also be learning about animals throughout February and so you can talk about what your child's favourite animal is and why they like them. Ask them to draw a picture of their favourite animal and use the activity to talk about the colour of the animals or the patterns on them. Bake some animal shaped biscuits and use the activity to bring in some mathematical skills such as talking about measurements and using language such as more and less

Toddler room

The children are reading "The Smartest Giant in Town" throughout February. You can read the story at home and talk about the characters asking questions such as "Which one is your favourite?" and "why?"

Talk about sharing and how nice it was of the Giant to give his clothes to the other characters. Ask your child to draw a picture of their favourite part of the story. You can encourage them to help fold the socks together, getting them to sort the socks into pairs.

Baby Room

The children in the babies are singing "Five fat sausages" this month. You can sing the song at home and use the props that we are sending home for you to use.

You can talk about cold and play with ice. Bake with them and talk about temperature.

Play with cornflour and water to develop sensory play and learn new vocabulary such as squelchy, wet and sticky.

Go for a winter walk and talk about there being no leaves on the trees.
