We hope you have all had a relaxing Christmas and are ready to start the New Year. All the children seemed very happy and excited to see one another again after the Christmas break and for the most part, appear to be settling straight back into nursery life.

Nursery Activities – Babies & Pre-School

Throughout December most activities involved glue, glitter and tinsel as staff and children prepared the nursery for the Festive Season. They were all kept busy making Christmas cards, calendars and various sparkly decorations which added a lovely festive feel to the nursery.

During December the babies had great fun they been developing their physical skills using different sensory materials. They have been exploring shaving foam, corn flour, play dough and sand to which we added glitter, Christmas scents and Christmas colours to, to enhance the experience. They have also listened to Christmas stories and developed their communication and language skills by singing new Christmas songs.

They have also enjoyed baking Christmas biscuits. The children helped to mix the ingredients together, roll out the dough and stamped out the biscuits.

The Pre-School children have been using flour in a variety of ways. They have been making marks and attempting to write their names. They also used their imagination to make buns; counting how many scoops they had developing their mathematical skills. They have also been extremely busy creating their own baubles, calendars and Christmas cards! The children have been using a variety of creative resources to create their very own masterpieces. This has helped the children's imaginative skills, motor skills and language skills. The children have been exploring the new tablet, with various educational games. This has helped the children develop technological skills and learn about cause and effect.
