#### Pre-School Room

This month we have been learning about Easter and taking part in lots of craft activities using and developing our creative skills and physical skills through using tools such as scissors.

### Things to do at home this month

#### Pre-School

The Pre school will be learning about science through the themes of dinosaurs, the world and weather. You can join in at home through drawing pictures of dinosaurs, talking about their names or even invent your own dinosaur.

You can play outside on a windy day and hold up ribbons or scarves and watch them blowing in the wind talking about how the wind feels. You could splash in puddles and talk about the sounds made introducing new vocabulary.

#### Toddler room

The Toddler Room will be learning about Spring Flowers and Spring Weather. You can join in at home by talking about the different types of weather and playing out in the different weathers.

You can paint pictures of different flowers talking about the colours and mixing different colours. You can go for a rainy day walk and splash in puddles and develop your child's physical skills.

You could also make flowers using playdough and talk about the different parts of a flower.

#### Baby Room

The children in the Baby Room will be developing their Personal, Social and Emotional Skills through singing songs and turn taking by looking at books and taking turns to turn the page.

You can encourage your child to make choices by giving them choices of fruit for snack. Support your child's emotional skills through having a go at an activity that is challenging and praising them to encourage a sense of self.
