Pre-School Room

The children in the pre school room have been learning about Autumn during October. They have enjoyed taking part in lots of activities that help develop their mathematical and literacy skills, including building a hedgehog house at the park and learning about hibernating animals. We have also used our woodwork skills to make wooden hedgehogs. We have explored natural autumnal materials such as conkers and pine cones and developed our mathematical skills by weighing the conkers and comparing weights and learning new mathematical language. We have also enjoyed mixing Autumn colours and printing with pine cones and conker rolling. We have explored our book of the month through tuff tray play, playing with puppets and reading the story "Owl Babies".

Starting School

If your child was born between 1 Sept 2020 and 31 August 2021 then they are due to start primary school in Sept 2025. To apply for a school place you must apply online by the 15th Jan 25 at www.calderdale.gov.uk/ admissions. The application process opens on the 18th Nov 24.

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Things to do at home this month

Pre-School

The children in the pre school are going to be learning about colours, Bonfire Night, Diwali and Remembrance Day during November.

You can join in at home by making a colourful collage using different materials. You can also paint pictures and mix different colours and talk about how mixing different colours together makes new colours

You could go for a walk and talk about the different colours that you can see out and about such as the different colours on the trees. You can look at books about colours and talk about your child's favourite colour

Toddler room

The children in the Toddler Room are going to be learning about colours and talking about Bonfire Night. You could take part at home by talking about the fireworks and the noises that they make introducing new vocabulary. You can paint pictures mixing colours and talking about what colours are needed to make different colours. You could make edible sparklers using breadsticks and introduce science concepts such as melting chocolate and it setting. You could look at books of colours and talk about your child's favourite colour.

Baby Room

The babies are also going to be focusing on colours. You can look at books about colours and talk about all the different colours of different things, such as the colour of the sky. You could also sing songs with colours in such as "I can sing a rainbow".

You can take part in sensory play with different coloured playdough naming the colours or you could add food colouring to the water and take part in water play. When out and about look for different coloured objects and items and name the colours.
